Mark Jenkinson	-	Sir Francis Bacon, Lord Chancellor Hatton, Admiral Martin, a Huguenot, a Murderer.
David Wheatley	-	The Earl of Leicester, a Murderer, a Huguenot, a Spanish Ship.

John Gale	-	Sir Robert Cecil, Rizzio, God, Archbishop Whitgift, a Huguenot, a Spanish Ship.
Joel Aryeety	-	An English Lord, a Huguenot, Paulet the Jailer, a Spanish Ship, Earth.
Anthony Early	-	An English Lord, Alencon the Dauphin, a Spanish Priest, a Huguenot, the Sun, Crest Keeper, a Spanish Ship.
Aidan Paddick	-	Tamburlaine the Dwarf, an English Lord, Walsingham, Lazarus Tucker, a Money Lender, a Spanish Ship.
Graham Osborne	-	The Count d'Aubigny and The Musician on Percussion and Bass.
Clive Stott	-	The Musician on Guitar and Synthesizer.
Alan Jamieson	-	The Musician on Brass.
