Members are reminded that the grounds of Hampton Court House are private, and not leased to the club. Consequently, they are not available for use by club members or their guests.

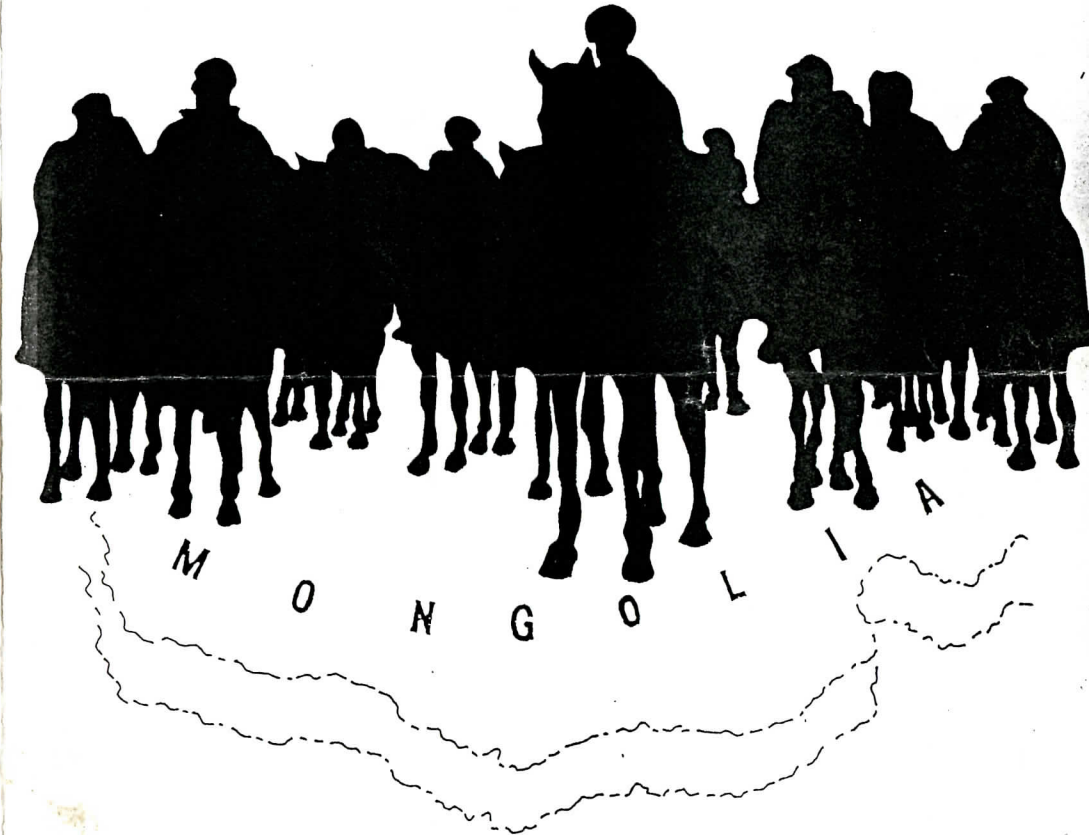
For the convenience of patrons, interval drinks may be ordered at the bar before the start of the performance.
